

# The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute Notice to Awardee

#### 1) COVID-19 measures

In line with Government requirements, The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute (Institute) adopts the following COVID-19 measures for attendees attending Annual Convocation 2022 (Convocation):

- i. To gain access to the Convocation, an attendee needs to:
  - Scan the QR Code with their 'LeaveHomeSafe' mobile app;
  - Allow venue staff to scan the **Blue** Vaccine Pass QR code;
  - Check body temperature (below 37.5 degrees Celsius).

(Note: In case of exemptions from complying with any of the above usual requirements, these should be communicated to the Institute before the Convocation.)

- ii. The following person(s) will <u>NOT</u> be allowed entry to the Convocation:
  - Those not complying with any items under (i) above;
  - Those subject to isolation/quarantine (e.g. wearing a Quarantine Order wristband) or in close contact with any such persons; and/or
  - Any person who has flu-like or respiratory symptoms.
- iii. Keep surgical face masks properly at all times during the Convocation.
- iv. Keep appropriate social distance in groups of no more than eight persons.
- v. Please observe good personal hygiene. Hand sanitisers will be supplied at the venue.
- vi. No food and beverage are allowed at the venue. Participants are encouraged to make their own arrangement beforehand.

\*The above measures will be subject to changes. The Institute will review the latest announcements from the HKSAR Government and impose appropriate steps accordingly.

## 2) Registration

All attendees are required to present the admission ticket at the designated registration counter upon arrival.

#### 3) Gown fitting arrangement

- i. Fellows, Associates and Graduates MUST wear an academic gown during the ceremony or otherwise, they will NOT be allowed to get on the stage.
- ii. In view of the large number of awardees, we recommend all awardees to arrive at the venue as early as possible for gown fitting and photo taking.
- iii. Gown fitting service will be available from 6.00pm to 7.00pm. No service will be arranged after 7.00pm.

#### 4) Certificate presentation

Please present the admission ticket to the Master of Ceremony for announcement of your name. Each awardee will take an individual photo with the official procession on stage.
