He was appointed by the Financial Services and Treasury Bureau of the Hong Kong Government to the advisory groups on the Rewrite of the Companies Ordinance and Modernisation of Corporate Insolvency Law. He is a joint director of Professional Diploma in Insolvency for The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. He had served The Hong Kong Institute of Chartered Secretaries as an examiner of the International Qualifying Scheme from 2005 to 2012.
