The new name will be effective after the Registrar of Companies' formal approval expected within one week. The Institute has also commenced a project to rebranding itself, and a revamping of its website towards the end of the year.


HKICS Employee Vaccination Incentive

The objectives of the Institute – as an independent professional body dedicated to the promotion of its members' role in the formulation and effective implementation of good governance policies – are contingent upon the public health of the city at large.

The Institute supports the Covid-19 vaccination programme as a means of curbing the spread of the coronavirus in the local community. Enforcement Series – Practical Review of Major Enforcement Regimes and Themes (Six Online Webinars)
