

### The Corporate Governance Code Changes – Masterclass on Practical Issues with Perspectives from Regulators, Issuers and Investors (Webinar)

**Date: Friday 25 March 2022**  
**Time: 4.30 pm – 6.00 pm**


In December 2021 HKEX announced a number of changes to the Corporate Governance Code and Listing Rules. The majority of these came into effect on 1 January 2022.

New measures to the Code include introducing culture to the board's agenda and making board diversity mandatory. The governance professional have to thoroughly understand the practical impacts of the measures. This will enhance the effectiveness in their role as trusted governance adviser.

The Institute has therefore invited regulators, major issuers' representatives, and investors to provide their perspectives. The aim is to provide a holistic understanding on the major governance related issues to the governance professional on matters, including culture, director's independence, diversity and shareholder communications, amongst others.
