The Institute and The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants will be supporting organisations.

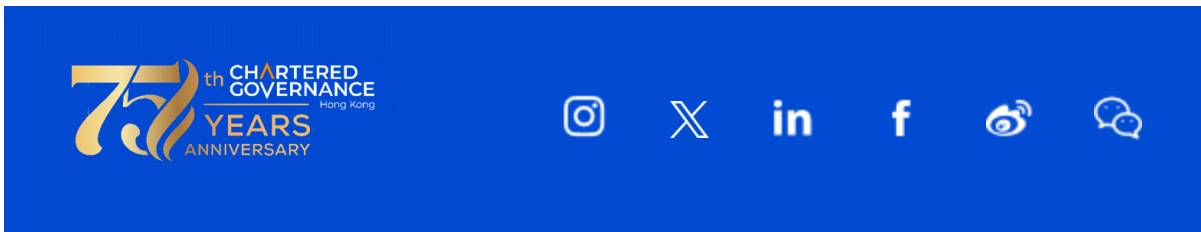
