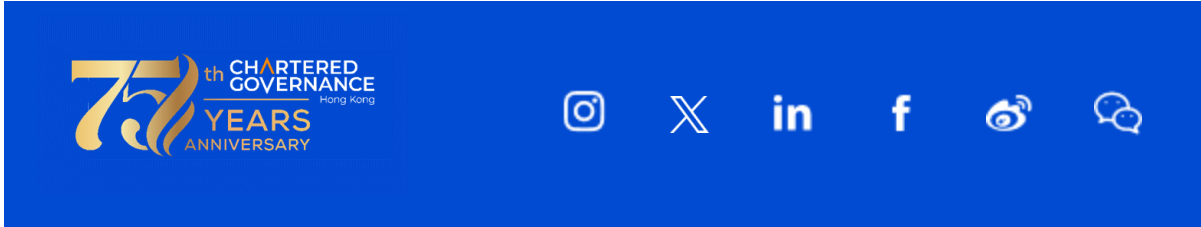
Hong Kong ESG Reporting Awards 2024
