Mrs Natalia Seng FCG HKFCG(PE) is a Chartered Governance Professional, a Council Member and Past President of The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute (formerly The Hong Kong Institute of Chartered Secretaries).

Natalia has been Vice Chairman of Tricor Hong Kong & Offshore for 2019 and she was the CEO of Tricor Hong Kong & China from 2012 to 2018. She was in the founding team of the Company Secretarial Practice of Ernst & Young in Hong Kong for two decades up to 2002, before the practice was sold to Tricor Group.

Natalia is a Council Member of The Hong Kong Committee for UNICEF and a member of its Corporate Governance Committee. She is also a Fellow of The Taxation Institute of Hong Kong. She has been an international Council Member of The Chartered Governance Institute formerly known as The Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators (ICSA) from 2010 to 2014.

In recognition of her contributions to the development of company secretary services and enhancement of corporate governance, Natalia was awarded “The Hong Kong Institute of Chartered Secretaries Prize 2017”. She has also been awarded an Outstanding PolyU Alumni by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University in 2019.

Natalia has been appointed by the Government as a member of the Standing Committee on Company Law Reform for three consecutive terms (February 2016 to January 2022).
