- **The State and Development of TCSP Regulations with Practical Sharing (webinar)**

In 2016, post-Panama Papers, the Institute as forerunner in Trust or Company Service Provider (TCSP) regulations, adopted the HKICS AML/CFT Guideline for TCSP self-regulation. The efforts were supported by the [HKICS AML/CFT Charter subscribers](#).

By 2018, under Hong Kong's National ML/FT Risk Assessment Report submitted to the Financial Action Task Force, it was recognised by the HKSAR Government that a substantial number of TCSPs are professionals including experienced Chartered Secretaries qualified with the Institute, particularly at the senior management level.

With official TCSP AML/CFT Guideline now in place, the Institute and the AML/CFT Charter subscribers continue to provide thought leadership and best practice sharing to the TCSP sector. Accordingly, this seminar on 25 November 2020 will cover:

- The state of TCSP regulations including those for selecting offshore jurisdictions
- The developing areas of TCSP regulations
- Practical sharing of TCSP practices by the AML/CFT Charter subscribers
